Psalm 66

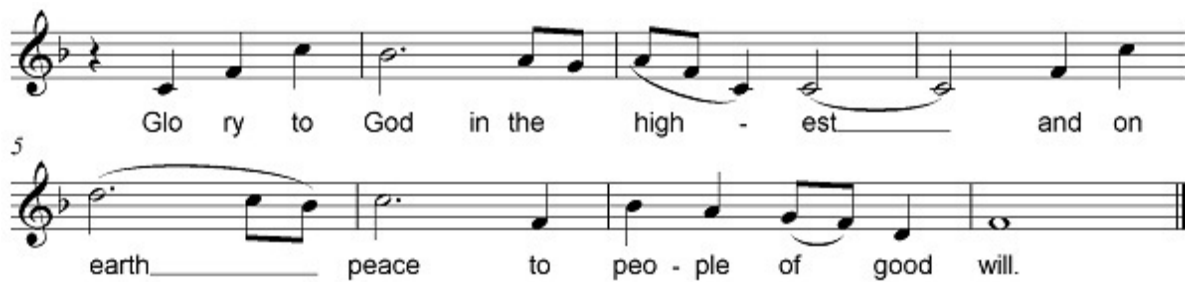


God, be gracious and bless us, let your face shed its light on us.
