All our demerits on Him fall.

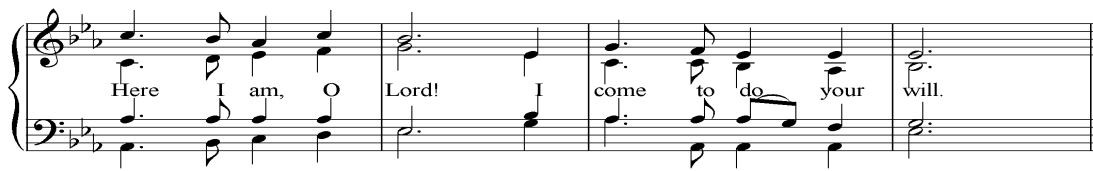
Once the most holy Child of salvation

Speak, O Lord, your servant hear!**

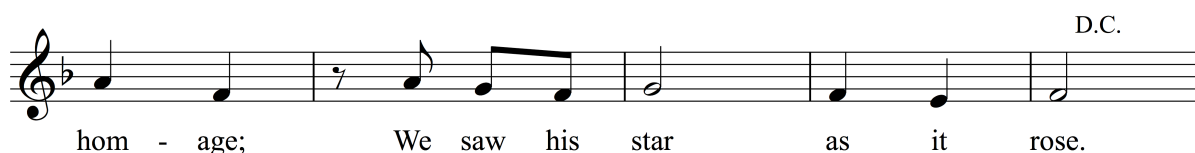
We pause for prayer then continue with the Gloria of the Mass

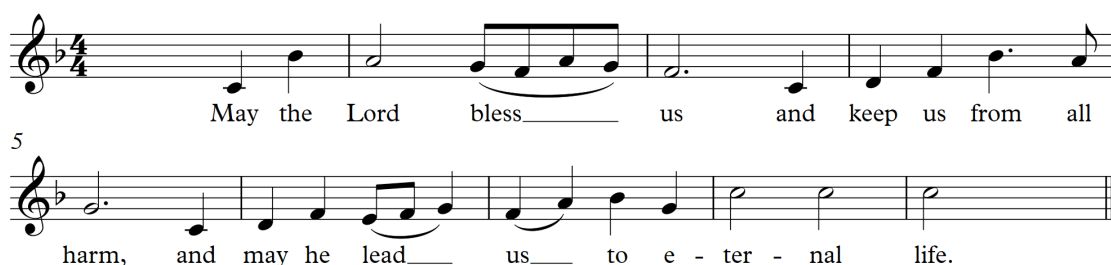
Communion:
