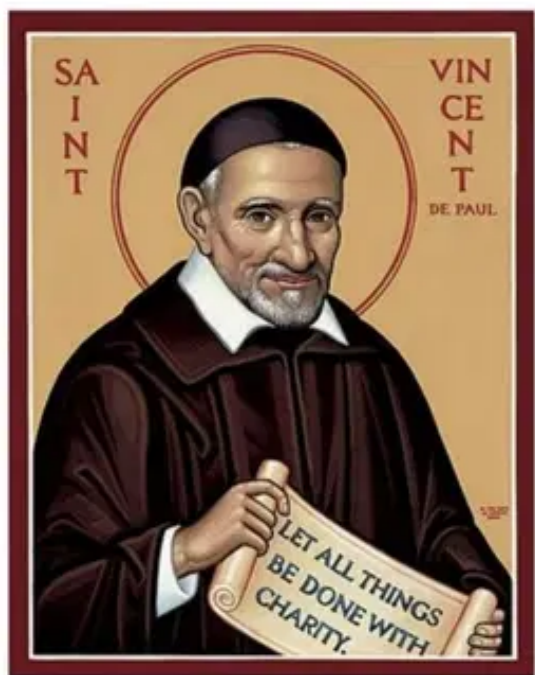

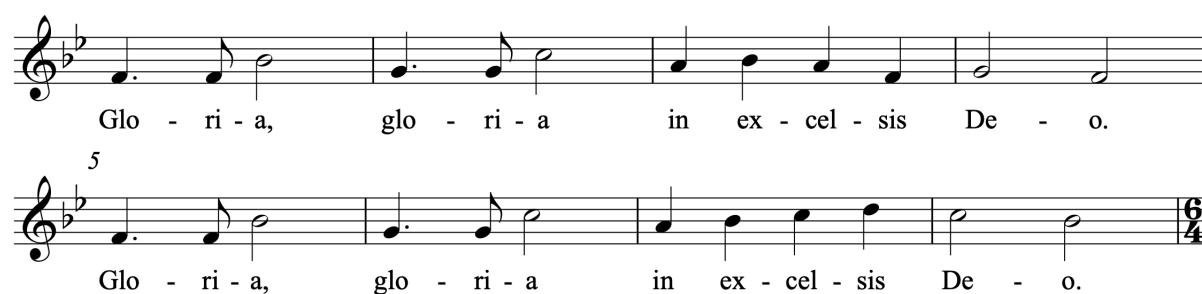
Penitential Act:

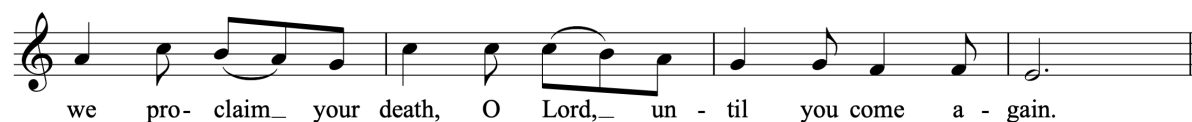
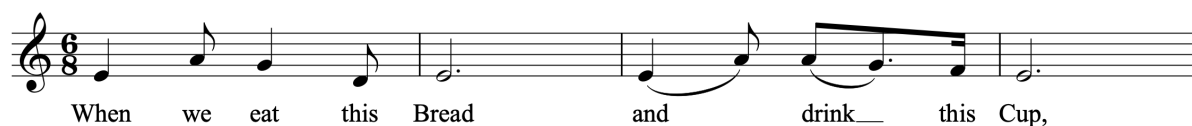
